

Toaster Oven Commemorative Groundrules

The Flights

Your team is in the Championship flight (potential score of 73 or less) if any of the following apply:

- Your team has shot 72 or lower within the past 4 years
- Your team has won the Competitive flight within the past 2 years
- The better player has a handicap index of 12 or less
- Both players have handicap indexes of 18 or less

Your team is in the Competitive flight (expected score 74 to 80) if any of the following apply:

- Your team has shot 78 or lower within the past 4 years
- Your team has won the Recreational flight
- The better player has a handicap index of 16 or less
- Both players have handicap indexes of 22 or less

Otherwise you are in the Recreational flight (expected score > 80).

- You are allowed to compete in the Championship or Competitive flights even though you don't "qualify"
- Any new team that scores 71 is kicked into the Championship flight
- Any new team in the Recreational flight that scores 74 or lower is kicked into the Competitive flight
- We reserve the right to modify the break point between flights as the makeup of the field dictates

Special Rules

You should follow the USGA rules of golf; however, the following local rules apply to the TOC:

Two-person scramble - Both players hit every shot, the team then selects the best shot to play next. This continues until you have finished the hole (including putts).

- Men play from the white tees.
- Women play from the red tees.

Playing the Ball Up - "Bumping" your ball up to one club length is allowed to improve your lie. This includes fairways, rough, sand bunkers, unmarked areas, and hazards. You cannot move out of a sand trap, out of a hazard, back from OB, or from the fringe to the green.

Double Bogey Rule - Nothing over a double bogey is allowed. Please pick up when you can no longer score a bogey on a hole.

Gimme Rule - Putts less than 2 feet are considered good.

Never a 4 Putt - All 3rd putts are considered good, so you don't even need to putt them.

Balls in Penalty Areas, Lost Balls, Unplayable Lies, and Out of Bounds - The change instituted in 2014 remains; these situations must be played per USGA rules. An exception is touching the ball in a hazard.

Special Contests

- Closest to the pin (separate divisions for men and women)
- Longest drive (separate divisions) - ball must be in the fairway
- Longest putt (one division)
